International and Domestic Fuel Hydrant - Closure

This notice is to advise that the BNE International and Domestic Fuel Hydrant system will temporarily be out of service to facilitate the replacement of the Master Switch.

Asset Description:	JUHI – BNE International and Domestic Fuel Hydrant Line (Please note: Domestic and International will be impacted)
Reason for outage (if known):	Planned engineering works to replace Master Switch
Steps to rectify:	7 hr JUHI Closure to BNE International Fuel Hydrant commencing 2300 Saturday 18 July
Expected date for return to service:	0600 Sunday 19 July
Operational impact:	Nil hydrant fuel will be available at both the International and Domestic terminals during outage period. Impacted airlines have been contacted directly by refuelling operators.
Workarounds:	Refuelling operators will work closely with airline customers to mitigate impact. The following are requested: • Complete final evening refuelling as early as practicable during aircraft turn arounds to enable timely start to shutdown • Maximise fuel uplift on inbound sectors where feasible • Provide return fuel on turnaround flights where operationally practicable • Provide advance fuel figures for aircraft operating close to the closure window Essential Services • Essential services (e.g. RFDS) will be supported via tanker fuel arrangements.
Next update:	• SMS notification will be issued prior to commencement of the outage • SMS notification will also be issued once fuel services are restored
