Domestic Terminal Security Upgrade Project

D63 Stakeholder Notice Northern Canopy (Airside Works)

OVERVIEW

As part of the Domestic Terminal Security Upgrade Project works are ongoing in the northern BMA to install the northern canopy and additional make-up loop.

Following on from the installation of the two steel posts outside of the make-up loop construction area, additional structural steel and canopy installation across the southern entry to the northern BMA is required. These works will be conducted as night works.

Northern Canopy Night works – Structural Steel & Roofing

The works program is:

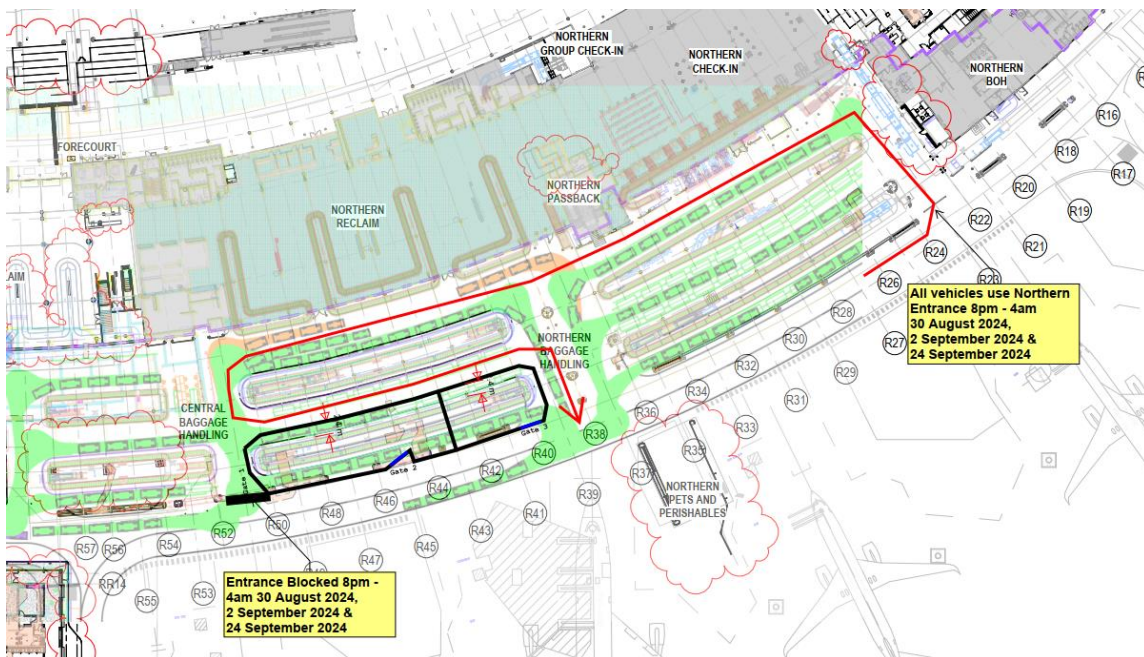
Structural steel - 23/9 - 8pm to 4am

Roofing install 25/9 - 8pm to 4am

IMPACT

The southern entrance to the northern BMA will be closed for the works duration with traffic control in place between 2000 – 0400.

All vehicles to use the northern BMA entrance during this period. See diagram below identifying drive paths.





As part of the construction of the entrance the NIGS on Gate 25 will be unserviceable until they can be relocated and rewired. This is scheduled for the 30 September 2024.

From the 23/09 to the 30/09 All aircraft movements on gate 25 will be required to be hand marshalled.
