DTB SUP Southern Loading Dock Exit - Auto Door Operator Installation

D76 Stakeholder Notice Issued: September 2024

OVERVIEW

Forming part of the Domestic Terminal Security Upgrade Project, the entire existing southern loading dock goods screening point will become a sterile space and require secured doors to maintain its security integrity.

To assist staff and tenants exiting with goods, trolleys and rubbish bins the double doors designating the sterile/landside exit point will be upgraded to an auto opening door.

SCOPE

The exiting doors from the loading dock will be out of order for the duration to allow for works required to install and activate the auto door hardware.

As of 17 September, 1700 the exit doors will be automated and not require manual intervention to push open doors.

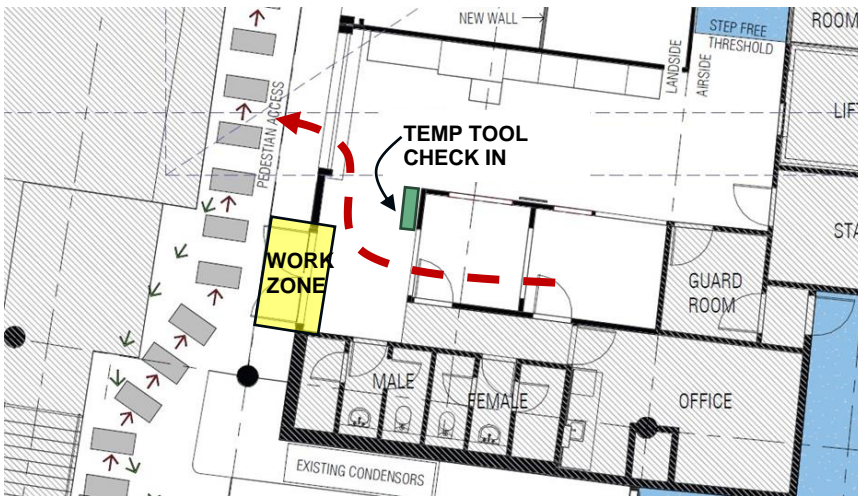
TIMING

Works will occur 17 September 0630 – 1700.

IMPACT

The Southern Loading dock will continue to operate with the exiting egress diverted while works are being undertaken.
