## Southern Loading Dock Goods Screening and Lift Temporary Closure –Lift Works

Stakeholder Notice: D78: 13 September

### OVERVIEW

As part of the Domestic Terminal Security Upgrade Project, the current southern goods lift will undergo a mechanical upgrade and undergo a refurb to make it suitable for passengers and DDA compliant for passengers with reduced mobility to access Level 2 departures.

This upgrade requires the lift to be shut down for these maintenance/upgrade works to occur.

### SCOPE

#### **Southern goods lift maintenance:**

Refurbishment and modernisation of door and lift control equipment.

#### **Southern goods lift level 2 foyer upgrade:**

Upgrade works will be completed on the level 2 lift foyer, including make good and painting of the walls, installation of a vinyl floor and wayfinding signage to direct exiting passengers out to departure gates. Signage indicating 'No entry. Authorised access only' will also be installed to ensure passengers do not attempt to enter the lift from level 2.

### TIMING

The works will take place **Thursday 19 September – Friday 27 September**.

### IMPACT/TENANT REQUIREMENTS

- Southern loading dock **goods screening and lift closed:**  
Thursday 19 September 0830 – Friday 27 September 2359.
- Southern loading dock open for **landside deliveries only:**  
Thursday 19 September 0830 – Friday 27 September 2359

All goods stored in the southern regional arrivals corridor and the temporary southern marquee storage area can continue to accept deliveries at the southern loading dock. Screening of stock for delivery to passenger facing tenancy within the sterile area will be allowed to utilise central screening during the **hours of 0900-1500**. Deliveries will only be allowed through the screening point in small manageable quantities (ie one

trolley) and movement of goods is required to occur along the domestic terminal forecourt (not inside the terminal). Outside of these hours movement of goods will be required to go northern loading dock and items be transferred in appropriate trolleys/cages and in a safe manner.

- Northern loading dock open 24/7:  
Thursday 19 September 0830 – Friday 27 September 2359
- All deliveries requiring goods screening to be diverted to the northern loading dock and northern goods screening for the duration of the works.  
- Erica Court, Brisbane Airport, QLD 4008
- All goods delivered to the northern loading dock for southern terminal tenants will need to be transferred through the terminal on level 2 concourse in appropriate trolleys/cages and in a safe manner.
- All rubbish to be removed from the terminal to the northern loading dock compactors/bins. Please ensure that all rubbish is bagged/binned appropriately for transportation. Additional collections will be conducted during the works period.
- Tenants to ensure that pallets, crates, kegs are removed immediately post delivery due to staging capacity constraints at the northern loading dock.
- Level 2 lift foyer will be closed for access:  
Thursday 19 September 0830 – Friday 27 September 2359
- Alternative access to leased areas from level 2 lift foyer to be utilised for the duration of the works.
