Domestic Carpark 2 Extension Project (P2X)

Update 11: September 2024

OVERVIEW

As part of the Domestic Terminal Car Park Expansion, the project is actively underway to enhance parking options for passengers at the P2 car park.

Sheet piles are necessary because of the excavation depth, as they will stabilise the land and prevent ground movement, thereby supporting the surrounding areas during the excavation process.

The crane tower base has been successfully installed and is currently curing before the remaining structure is added. Pouring the crane base marks a significant milestone for the project

STAKEHOLDER IMPACTS – SHEET PILING

Working hours: 6 am to 6 pm

Date: September 23 to September 26.

Impacts: Vibration noises near the southern facade of the P2. Noise levels are expected to align with the recent piling, as the sheet piling, like the previously used displacement piling method, is vibrated into place.
