FIRST AID ROOM

BACKGROUND

As part of the Domestic Terminal Building Security Upgrade Project, the existing offices located on level 1 behind the central check in desks are to be demolished commencing 25 September 2024.

The current First Aid room, located level 1 CUT, will be temporarily closed for a 5 week period and first aid stock being stored in the BAC Offices, Level 2 CUT and then relocated to the new location First Aid Room in the southern end of the terminal.

The provision of a first aid room is not a regulated requirement, but is a service that Brisbane Airport provides for its passengers, staff and stakeholders.

SCOPE

20 September – Current First Aid room closed and stock relocated to BAC Offices, Level 2.

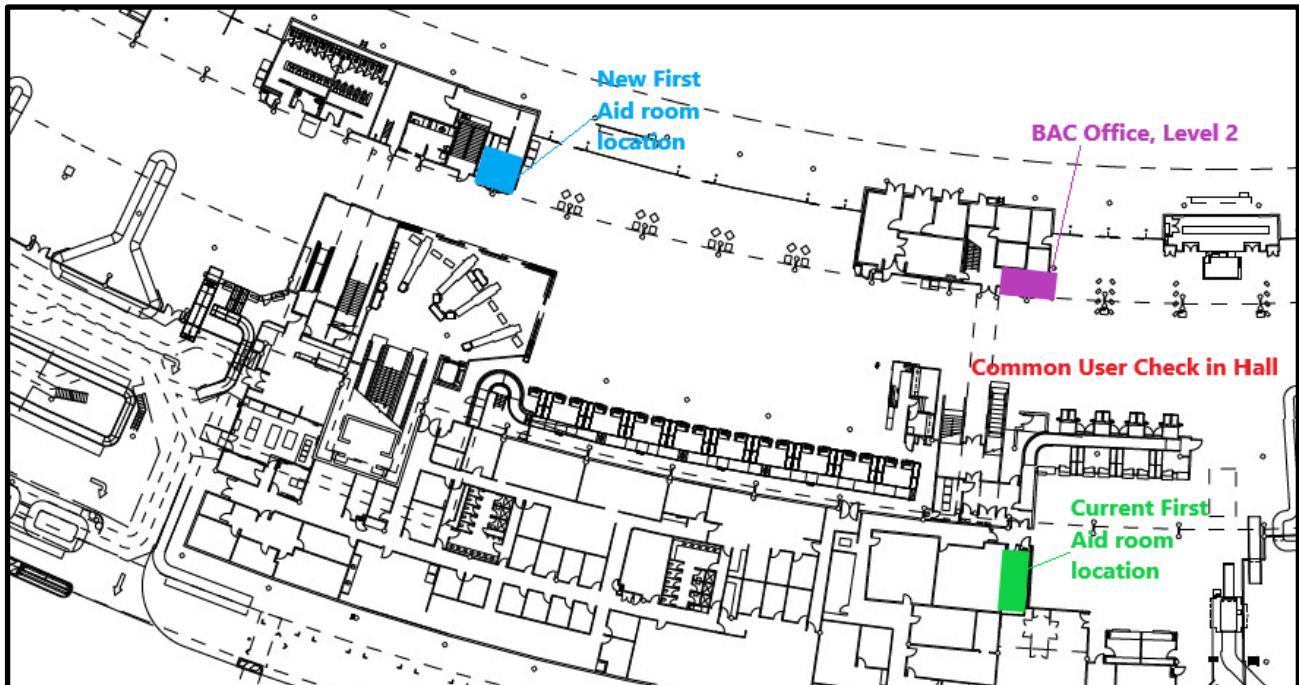
25 September – demolition works to commence on the current First Aid Room.
