## Vertical Transport – Domestic Terminal Southern Goods Lift

D149 Stakeholder Notice Issued: 14 January 2025

Brisbane Airport Corporation (BAC) is mandated to perform upgrades to our vertical transport to ensure the safety of the Airport and its facilities and compliance to regulatory requirements.

### OVERVIEW

To maintain regulatory compliance for vertical transport at the Airport, BAC will be undertaking a compliance upgrade of the lift.

### IMPACT

Please be advised that the upgrade has been scheduled at the Domestic Terminal for the southern goods and passenger (level 1 to 2 for Security Screening passengers) lift (LEDTBLIFTS2) on the following dates and times after the last departing flight:

- Monday night 20<sup>th</sup> of January – 2130 to 0330
- Tuesday night 21<sup>st</sup> of January – 2130 to 0330
- Wednesday night 22<sup>nd</sup> of January – 2130 to 0330
- Thursday night 23<sup>rd</sup> of January – 2130 to 0330

During the above-stated periods, the southern goods and passenger lift will be out of service and unable to be used.

Any goods, staff and public who require access via a lift to level 2 during this period will be required to use the northern goods, staff and passenger screening points.
