As part of the BAC DTB Multi-Level Carpark Expansion Project, Managing Contractor ADCO will undertake lighting relocation works across multiple levels of the P2 Carpark, commencing on 6 August 2025. These works are essential to upgrade and commission new lighting infrastructure in alignment with safety, energy efficiency, and compliance standards to enable handovers.

## Scope of Works

**Date:** Wednesday, 6 August 2025 – 26 August 2025

**Time:** 9:30 AM – 6:00 PM

The scope includes:

- Installation and commissioning of new light fittings.
- Decommissioning and safe removal of existing light fittings.
- Traffic control measures including road closures, signage, and crowd control barriers.
- Exit-only traffic management monitored by designated personnel.
- Work zones will be split into small sections to allow circulation.
- Temporary blanking of new exit signage to avoid confusion until hoarding is removed .

**Schedule of Works:** Lighting relocation will occur progressively across Levels 1 to 6. For example (referenced work zones available below in Lighting works):

- **Level 1:** Workzone 1 on 6 Aug, Workzone 2 on 7 Aug, Workzone 3 on 8 Aug.
- **Level 5:** Workzone 1 on 9 Aug, continuing through to Workzone 3 on 12 Aug.
- Works continue through to **Level 6**, concluding on **26 August 2025**
- **Please note:**
  - **There is a possibility for the days of each level to be changed to suit operations.**
  - **The work Zones referenced below are subject to change and show a general set out.**
  - **Set out may differ from level to level to accommodate needs.**

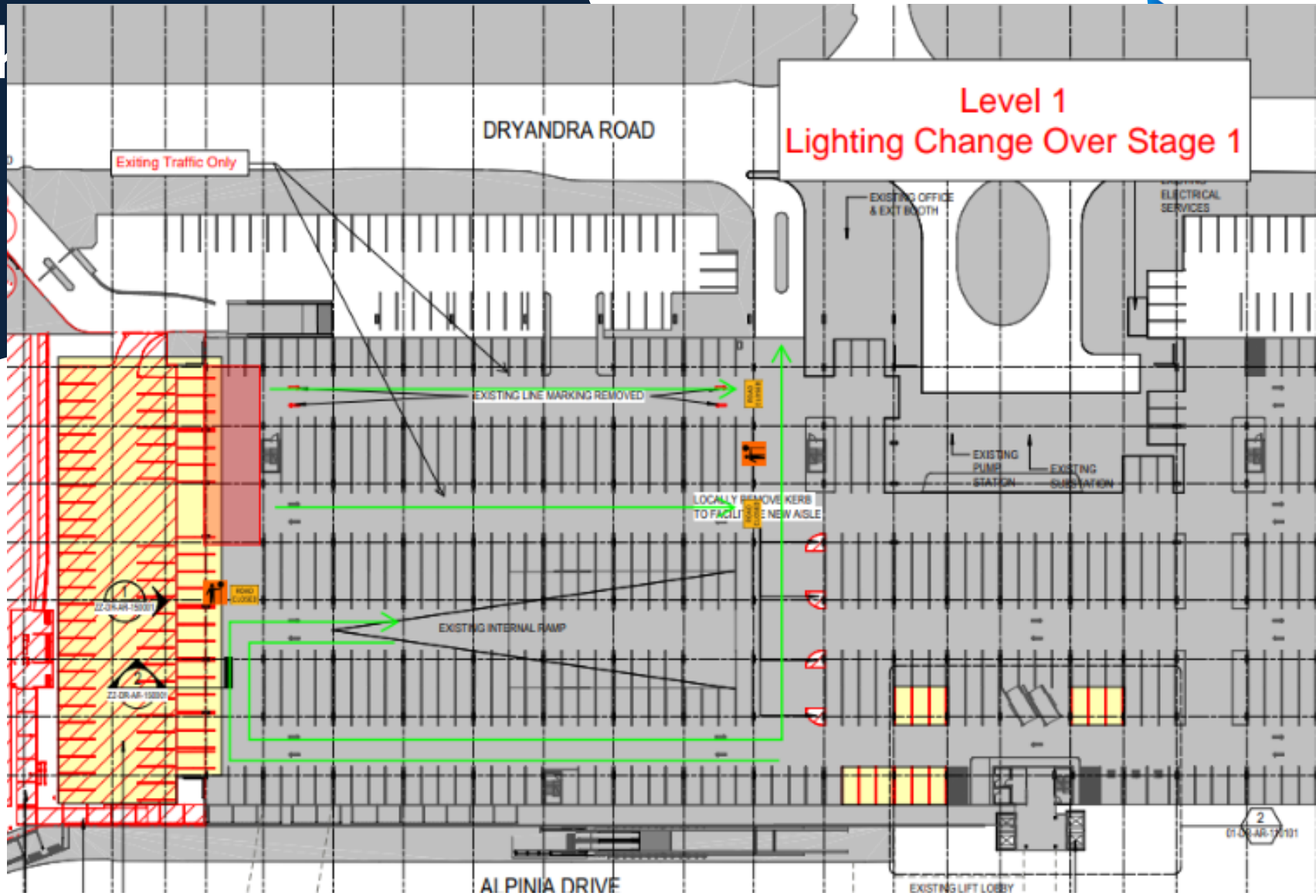
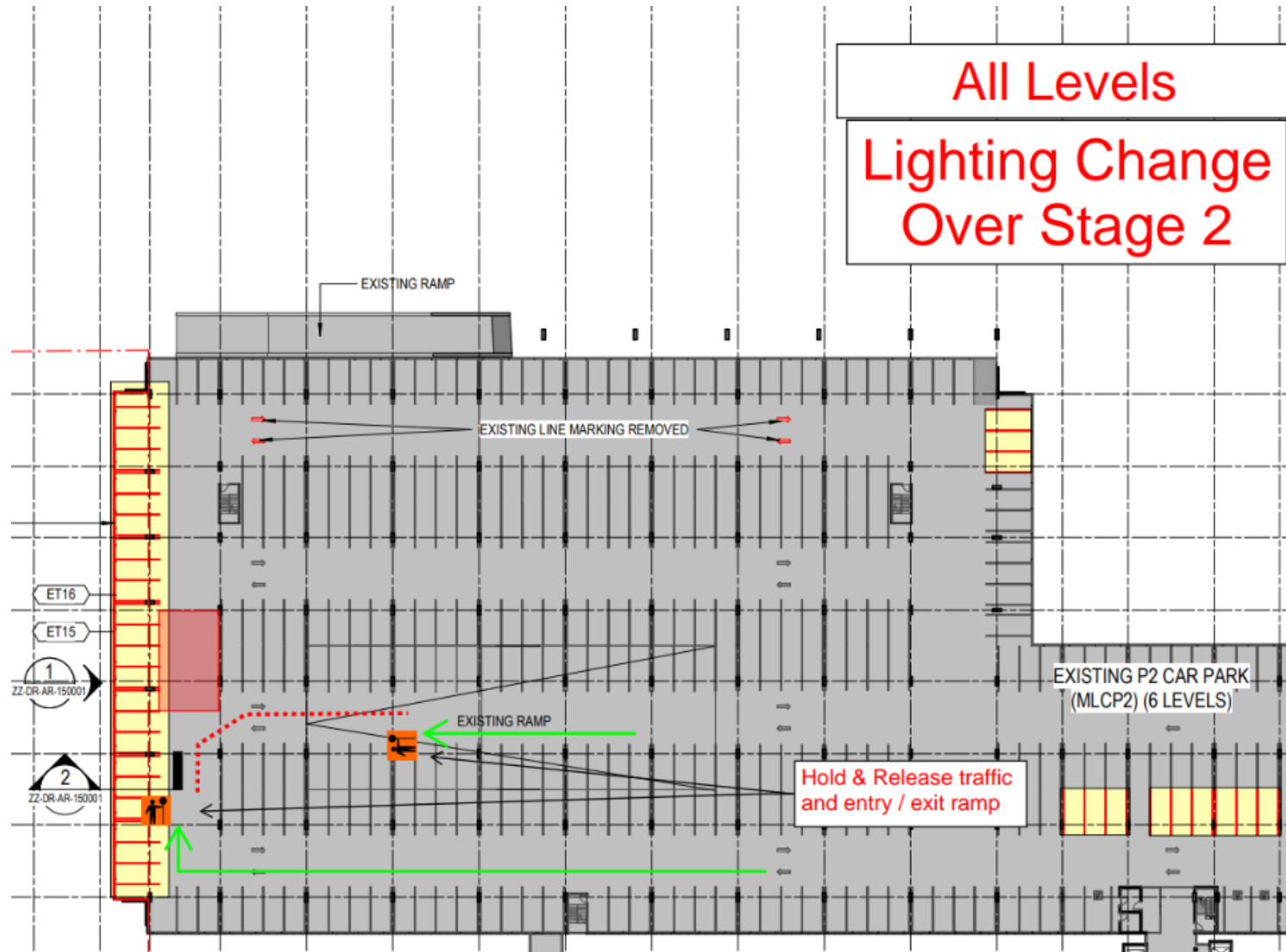
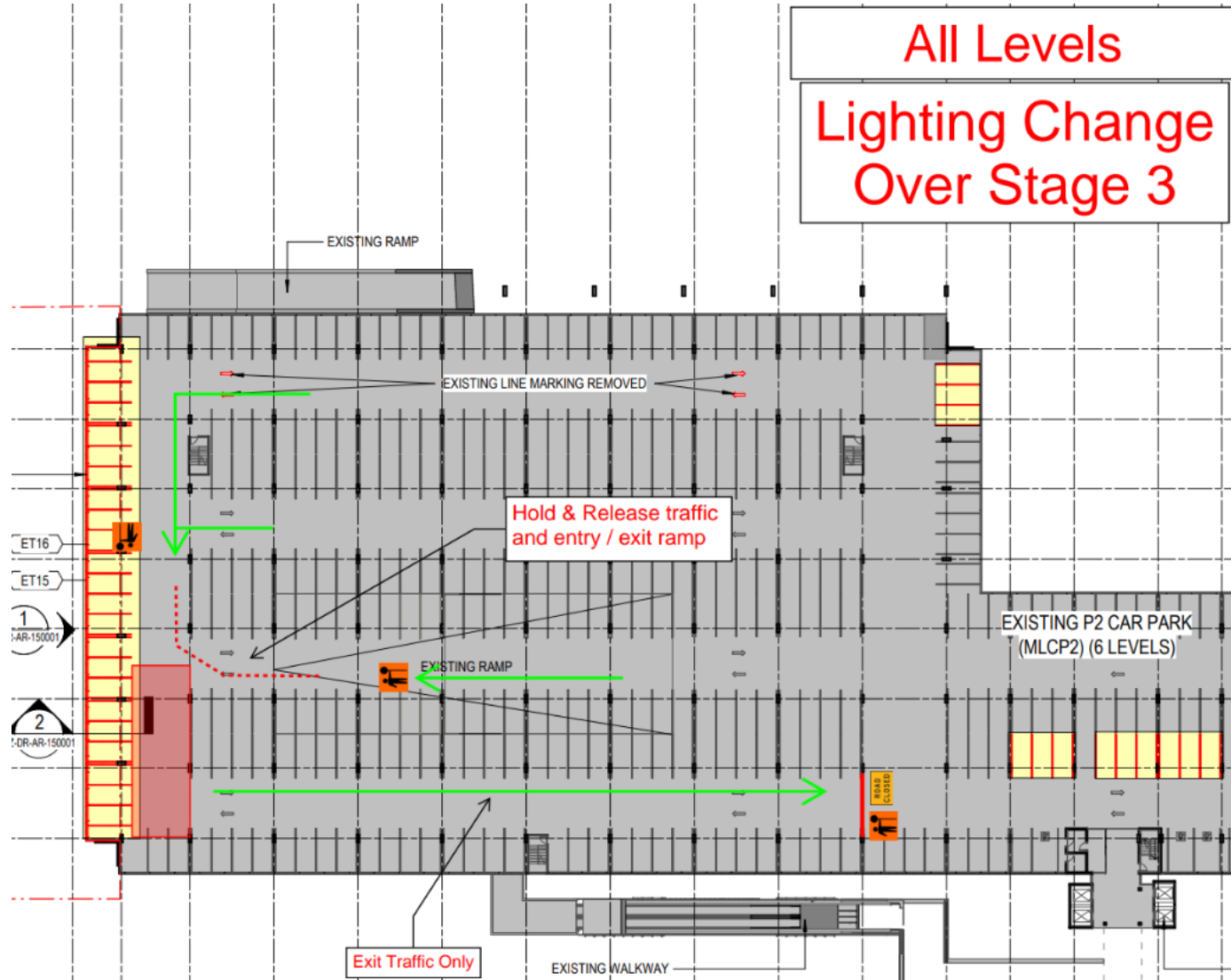


Figure 2 Level 1

## Impacts

### Fire Booster System:

- **General Construction Noise:** Expect typical construction noise during the upgrade process, which may include sounds from machinery, drilling, and other construction activities.
- **Traffic Management:** Temporary shutdowns of Lanes (passengers will always be able to egress).
- **Safety Measures:** Temporary fencing and other safety measures will be in place to ensure the safety of all personnel.
