Brisbane Airport Corporation (BAC) is mandated to perform Switchboard and RCD testing on a Twelve-monthly basis to ensure the electrical safety of the Airport and its facilities.

## Location

Domestic Terminal Building, Skywalk & P1 Car Park

## Scope of Works

To maintain statutory compliance for electrical safety at the Airport, BAC must conduct 12 monthly testing of Switchboards and RCD protected circuits on all BAC-maintained distribution boards across the precinct.

The tests itself involves, injection testing and thermos scanning of distribution boards and the manual 'tripping' of each circuit on an individual basis to test performance and complete necessary maintenance.
