As part of the Domestic Terminal Car Park Expansion Project, ADCO Constructions will be undertaking hoarding relocation works on Alpinia Drive (from the garden into the footpath) to facilitate the completion of excavation, civil, and pavement works inside P2X site.

To safely carry out these activities, barriers will be set up during the works, and traffic controllers will be in place to manage pedestrian movements.

The works are scheduled to occur between Monday, 29 September and Tuesday, 30 September 2025. This notice outlines the planned activities, schedule, scope of works, and key safety controls to ensure minimal disruption and the safety of all road users and stakeholders.

## Schedule

**Dates:** Monday, 29 September to Tuesday, 30 September 2025

**Times:** 6:00am – 3:00pm

## Scope of Works

- All hoarding cutting and related activities will occur inside the P2X site area only, avoiding any direct impact to pedestrians.
- Hoarding posts will be fixed to the concrete walkway, utilising the existing walkway thickening where posts are installed.
- Crowd control barriers installed to delineate the work area and ensure a minimum 1m clear travel path.
- A Traffic Controller on-site at all times, working alongside hoarding installers to assist pedestrian movement; the Traffic Controller will stop installation activities whenever pedestrians' approach from either direction, allowing safe passage before work resumes.
- As the hoarding installation progresses, workers will clear debris promptly in line with their SWMS, ensuring no trip hazards are left along the walkway.
- Hoarding remains black-painted, with no impact to existing signage or lighting.

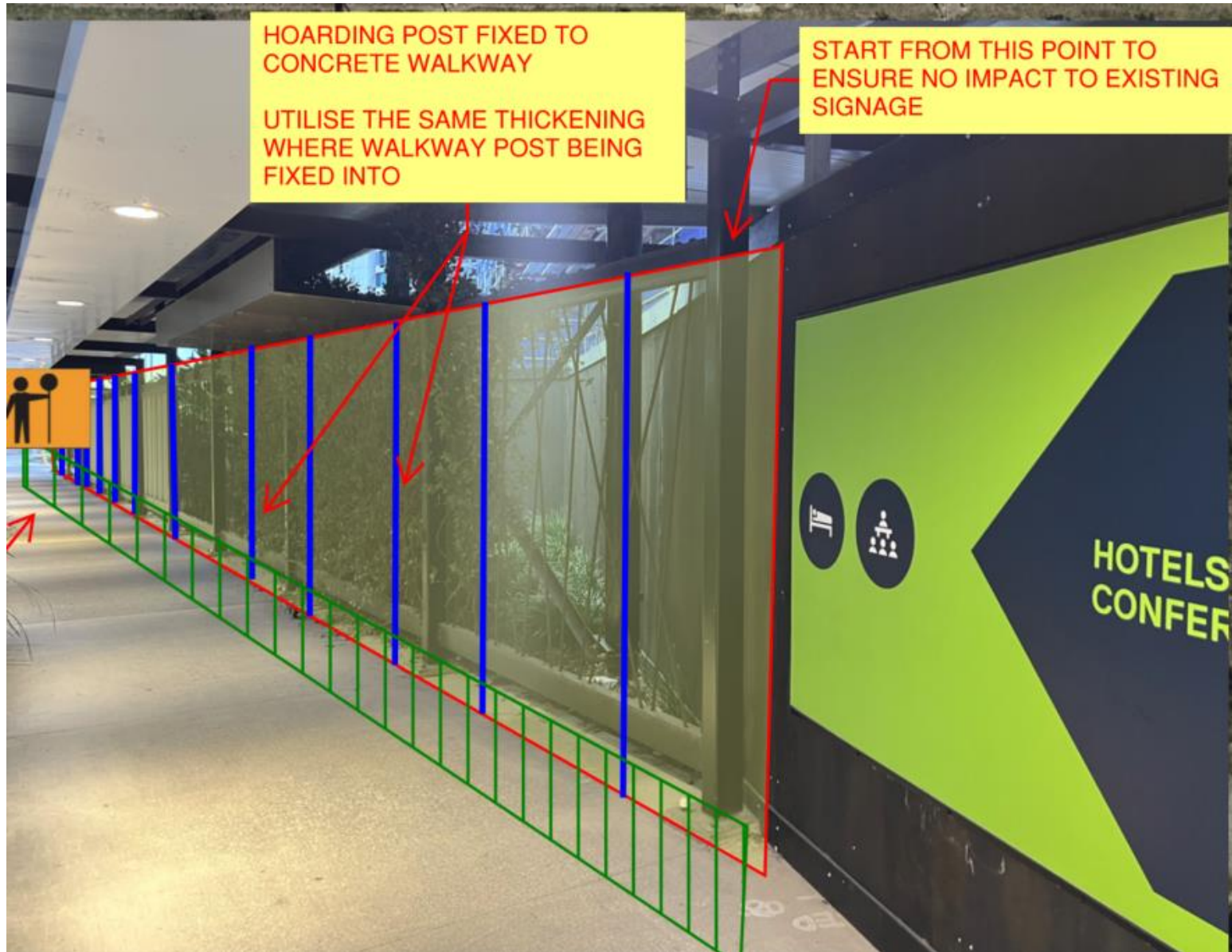


Figure 3: Proposed Hoarding Line



## Impacts

- **General Construction Noise:** Expect typical construction noise during the hoarding relocation.
- **Traffic Management:** Temporary traffic control will be in place on Alpinia Drive, with traffic controllers assisting pedestrians as needed.
- **Pedestrian Management:** Pedestrian access will be maintained, with temporary crowd barrier setting up.
- **Safety Measures:** Temporary barriers, signage, and other safety controls will be implemented to ensure the safety of all personnel and the public.
