

# Stakeholder Notice

## DTB Recycled Waterline Relocation Project

BAC will be undertaking the relocation of the existing recycled waterline at the Domestic Terminal Building, with works 17 October - 29 November 2025.

### Location

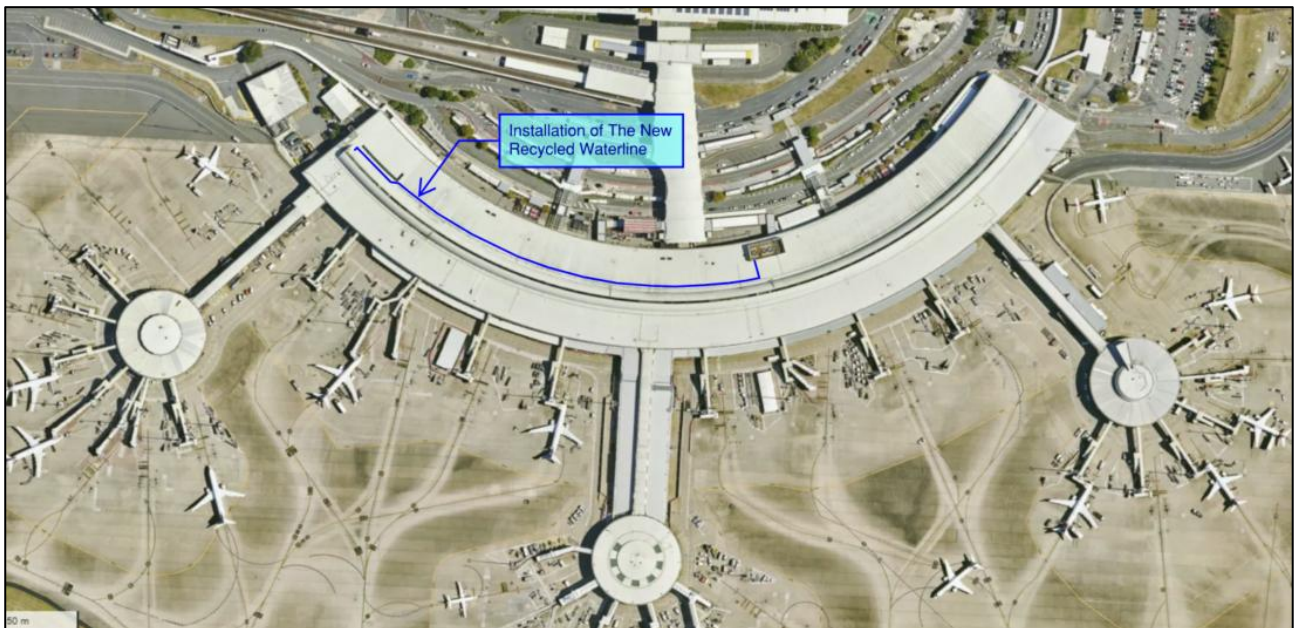


Figure 1: Site Location

The works will take place on the roof of the Domestic Terminal Building, where the new pipe will be installed along the walkway access, as shown below in Figure 1.

### Scope of Works

The project involves the installation of approximately 300 linear meters of new pipeline on the roof of the Domestic Terminal Building:

1. Installation of a new DN90 PE pipeline, fixed to the roof sheeting.
2. Installation of pipe protection, including metal sheeting and hat covers.
3. Removal of the existing recycled waterline, where feasible, post new line being operational.

The works are scheduled to commence on **Friday, 17 October 2025**, and are expected to continue until **Saturday, 29 November 2025**, weather permitting.

**Key Dates:**

**Friday 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025 – Site Mobilisation**

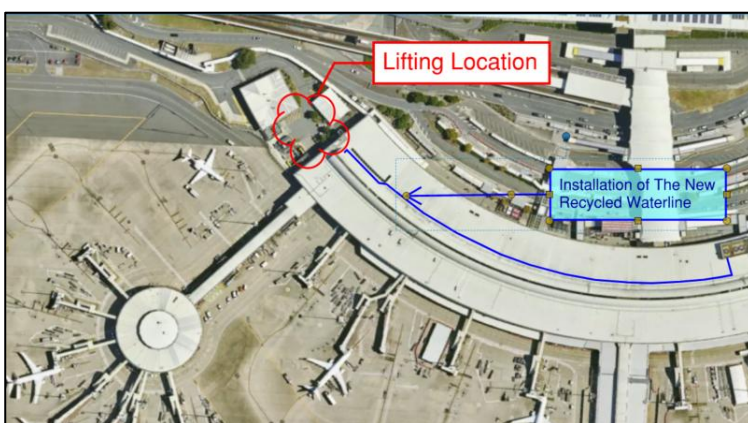


Figure 2: Lifting Location

Mobilisation works will include the temporary stockpiling of materials and equipment in approved areas at the southern loading dock, as shown in Figure 2.

**Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2025 – Crane Lifting (Material Storage)**

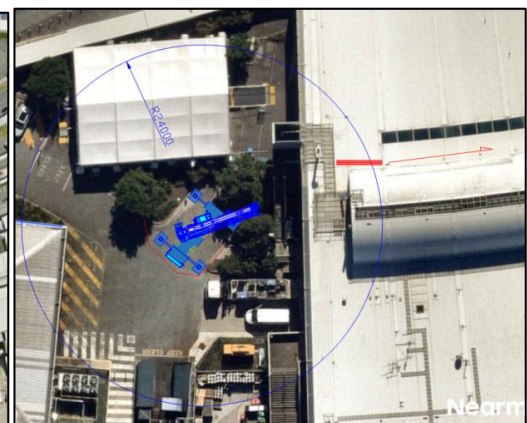


Figure 3: Temporary Laydown and Crane Lifting

Crane lifting activities will be carried out to transport materials and equipment onto the roof, as shown in Figures 2 & 3.

**Saturday 22<sup>th</sup> November 2025 – Crane Lifting (Demobilisation and Site Clearing)**

Crane lifting activities will also be undertaken to remove equipment and unwanted materials from the roof as shown in Figures 2 & 3.

Note: This date is tentative and will be confirmed prior to the commencement of any lifting works. It is subject to work progress and weather conditions.

## Impacts

The only expected impact will occur during lifting operations, which will affect access to the south side of the Domestic Terminal Building.

To ensure safe access during these operations, the following mitigation measures will be implemented:

- A Traffic Management Plan will be provided by a qualified traffic engineer.
- Lifting activities will be scheduled and completed outside of peak hours, on Saturday **between 08:00AM and 03:00PM**. During this period, there is an expectation that traffic may be held for approx. 10 minutes during lifts or the northern loading dock will be available for use.
- The southern goods screening point will not be impacted during the lifting operation. However, any movement within the crane lifting zone need to be communicated to provide safe access to the screening point.
