DTB Carparks P1 & P2 Joints Replacement Project

BAC will undertake the replacement of existing joints on all levels of the Domestic Terminal Car Parks P1 and P2, with works scheduled from 14 October to 7 December 2025.

Location

The works will take place on the roof of the Domestic Terminal Building, where the new pipe will be installed along the walkway access, as shown below in Figure 1.

Scope of Works

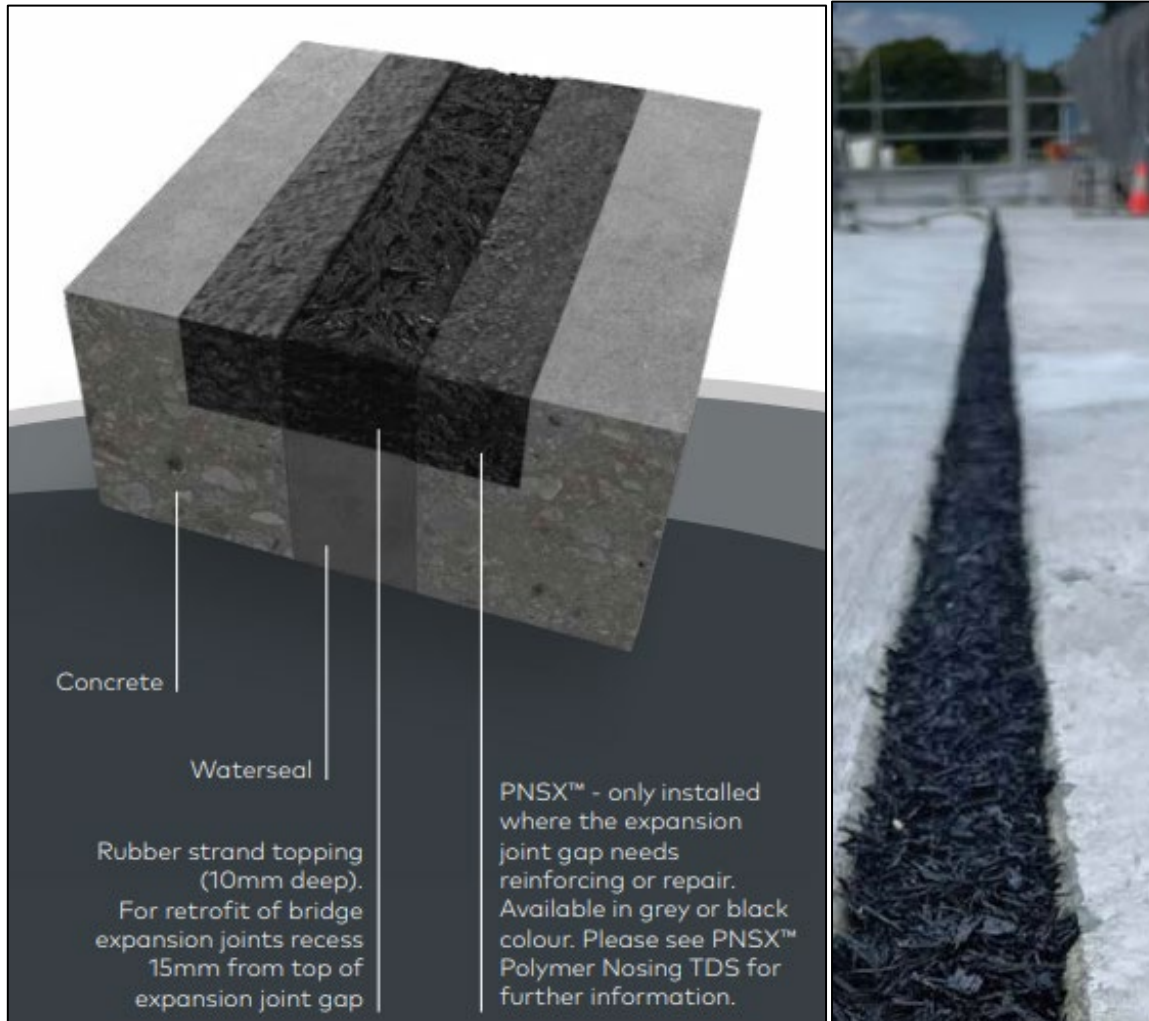


Figure 2: New joint System

The project involves the replacement of approximately 1,500 linear metres of defective existing joints with a new joint system at the Domestic Terminal Car Parks P1 and P2. The works will take place across all levels — P1 from Levels 2 to 9, and P2 from Levels 2 to 6 — as shown in Figure 2 below.

The works are scheduled to commence on **Tuesday, 14 October 2025**, and are expected to continue until **Sunday, 07 December 2025**.

Impacts

The works are expected to impact car park operations, including the closures of few car bays and traffic diversions.

To ensure safe access and minimise disruption to car park operations, the following mitigation measures will be implemented:

- A traffic controller will be onsite to assist passengers and support car park operations.
- The team will liaise with the BAC Car Park Operations team daily, both before implementing any traffic controls and after the completion of works, to ensure safe access without disrupting operations.
- Work hours will remain flexible during day to avoid any impact on car park operations.
