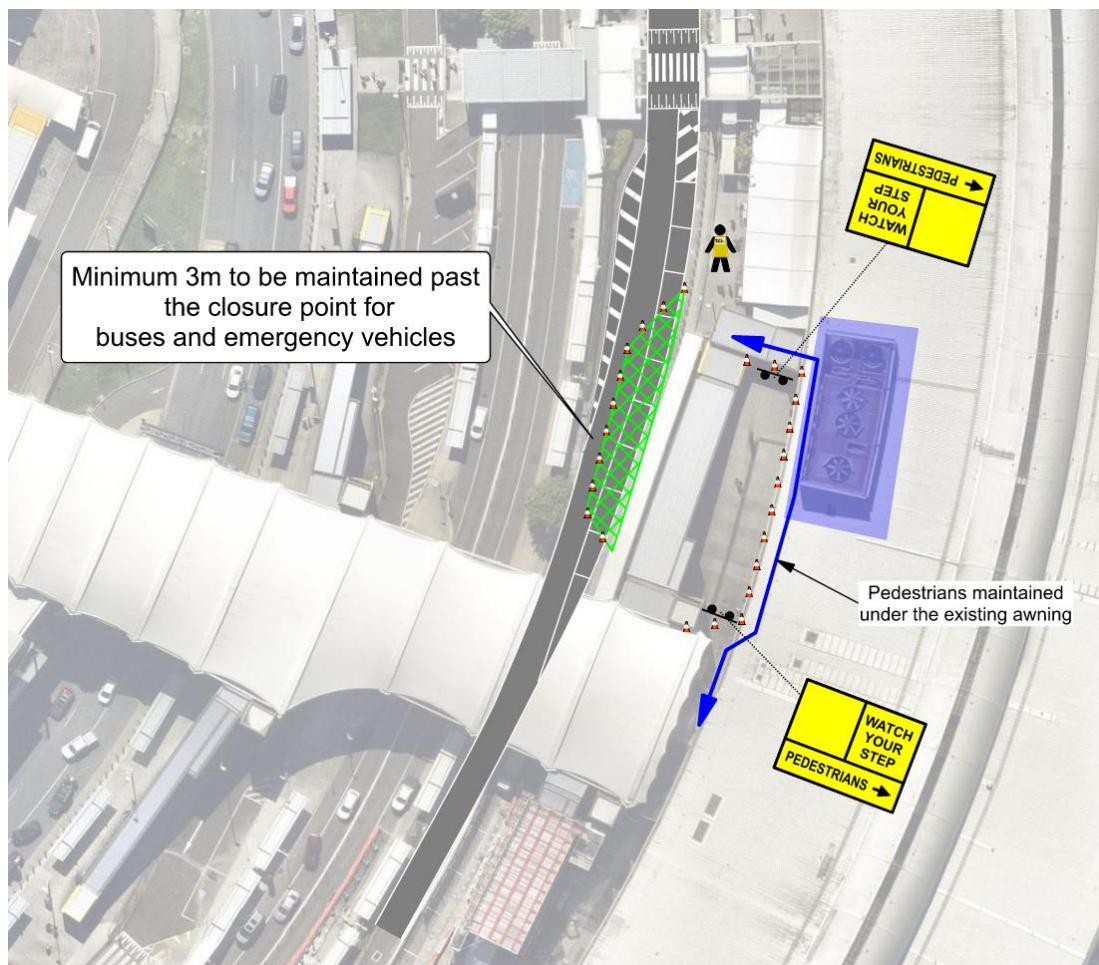

The Domestic Terminal Cooling Tower Motor Replacement requires a new cooling tower motor to be craned over the Domestic Terminal Forecourt from Road 1.

Location

The location for this crane lift will occur north of the Skywalk adjacent to the temporary Jetstar check in area.



Scope of Works

These works will require a crane to be setup on Road 1 in front of the Domestic Terminal to allow a new cooling tower motor to be lifted into the plant deck of the terminal.

The details of the lift day and times are as follows:

- Primary lift date – 21st October - midnight to 4am 22nd October – 4 hours (max)
- Secondary back up date 22nd October - midnight to 4am 23rd October – 4 hours (max)

The crane lift will commence after last arrival to ensure minimal passenger and staff impacts.

Impacts

Works will occur post last arrival.

Traffic control will be in place to along the incoming roadways to notify of the works ahead. Taxis entry lane will be blocked off. Buses will operate as normal. Pedestrians will be required to find an alternative path during the crane lift to ensure no movement under the crane.
