DTB Southern Retail Upgrade

Update 2: July 2023

BACKGROUND

The Domestic Terminal Retail Upgrade will offer exciting new options for passengers at Brisbane Airport. They include a fresh modern experience, with upgrades to food and beverage offerings at the southern part of the Domestic Terminal, as well as upgrades to seating and furniture to provide passengers with comfort before they fly.

REFURBISHMENT / WORKS

Works 20-21st of July

From 11pm to 4am the team will commence the first stage of hoarding and defit in the Domestic Terminal. The sub-contractor completing the works have worked extensively in the terminal. Should they experience delays or issues they will communicate via the agreed project channels. Decal will be installed 21/07 by Unita during the day, which will feature the hoarding designs.

Works 23-24th of July

Red Rooster will commence its temporary closure from the 23/07 until later in the year. The area will be hoarded from 11pm on the 24/07 as part of stage 2A (refer to map)

Change of from 28th of July to 3rd August

These works are now scheduled to start on the evening of August 3rd.

The first part Stage 1C and gate 40B seating area will commence hoarding and defit on the evening of the **3rd of August from 11pm**. Gate 40B will remain operational during these works. Additional priority seating allocation is being discussed.
